Did you know that sourcing almonds from Rainforest Alliance Certified farms has wonderful benefits for businesses? It can help companies to minimize risk, promote responsible supply chains, and meet their sustainability commitments. It also helps make a product more appealing to consumers and raises a company's standing and reputation among investors, buyers, employees, and the industry.

CHALLENGES IN THE ALMOND SECTOR

As almond farming has expanded to meet the surge in health-conscious eating and plant-based diets, much of that growth has been centered in California—where an astonishing 80 percent of the world's almonds are grown. From 2011 to 2022 alone, the total acreage state's commercial almond orchards jumped from 760,000 acres to more than 1.3 million!

While California is known for its highly professional mega-orchards, almond farming is not without its challenges:

- Water management: Almond farming is thirsty work, with about 3.2 gallons of water needed to produce a single nut. This is a significant environmental concern, especially in drought-prone places like California.
- **Bee colony health:** Farmers depend on bees to pollinate their almond trees. While responsible growers are building and supporting new hives, over-reliance on pesticides and other toxic chemicals can decimate bee populations.


THE RAINFOREST ALLIANCE ALMOND PROGRAM

Since 2023, the Rainforest Alliance has been helping ranches in California to boost their climate resilience and embrace regenerative growing practices.

Rainforest Alliance Certified almonds are grown in accordance with the strict guidelines of our Sustainable Agriculture Standard. These include environmental protections, such as conserving biodiversity and natural resources, as well rigorous social criteria, such as improving the well-being of farmers, workers, and their families. Our standard requires farms to manage and report on their water usage and adopt an Integrated Pest Management approach that reduces pests while protecting pollinators. Almond orchards also embrace regenerative agriculture techniques—like using cover crops

and setting aside areas to conserve and grow ecosystems—to help bolster biodiversity and improve soil health.

The Rainforest Alliance works with accredited third-party auditors to inspect farms and farm groups against our program's farm requirements. Likewise, businesses are audited against supply chain requirements. Those that meet the certification requirements can use the Rainforest Alliance Certified seal. Over 40,000 food, beverage, and forestry products across the globe already proudly display our green frog seal, which shows both businesses and individuals that the product contributes to a better future for people and nature.

- Farmer trainings: Our certification program drives sustainability transformation from the ground up by supporting farmers with innovative training, data tools, and technical assistance.

SUSTAINABILITY IS GOOD BUSINESS

Sustainability in sourcing and the supply chain brings direct benefits to people and the planet while driving business value. A wide array of research studies has demonstrated measurable positive business impacts:

- · 43 percent of businesses experience sales and marking benefits after adopting sustainability standards these include areas such as improved reputation (33 percent), increased profitability (23 percent), cost reduction (25 percent), and improved resilience (20 percent).1
- · Consumers are more likely to trust a product with the Rainforest Alliance seal: 63 percent of consumers in the UK, 49 percent in Germany, 44 percent in the Netherlands, 47 percent in France, and 51 percent in Sweden.2
- Certification boosts brand reputation: 60 percent of British consumers, 50 percent of German, 36 percent of Dutch, 50 percent of French, and 48 percent of Swedish say that seeing the Rainforest Alliance seal on a product improves their opinion of a company.3
